



Top Questions for Faculty to Ask Unit Nurse Managers:

1. What type of patients do you normally admit to your unit?
2. What type of patients on your unit should not be assigned to a student?
3. What patient safety concerns are most important for your unit (i.e., fall, CLABSI, CAUTI prevention)?
4. What is the best way to ensure students have a positive experience?
5. Is there a location on the unit where students may put their belongings and where post conference can be conducted?
6. What computers should the students use for charting?
7. When is the best time for students to get report from the unit RNs?
8. Does the unit participate in pre-shift huddles?
9. Where is the emergency equipment located?
10. What patient concerns need to be escalated to the RN caring for the patient?
11. What is the contact information for your unit recruiter?
12. What type of open positions do you have for new students and nurses?
13. Will you be hosting a recruitment event on your unit for students?
14. What is the “get-to-know” me process for students on the unit?
