<p>Material Safety Data Sheets</p> <p>In case of exposure to chemicals, obtain the MSDS sheet from the computer (MSDS Binderview icon in Citrix) or from department. Ask staff or instructor for assistance.</p>	<p>Rapid Response Team: Dial 88888</p> <p>The Rapid Response Team is a team of health care providers who serve as a resource for the general nursing units where there is an actual, perceived or suspected deterioration or change in the patient condition</p>
<p>FIRE Response</p> <p>R=Rescue A=Alarm C=Contain E=Extinguish</p>	<p>FIRE Response</p> <p>P=Pull A=Aim S=Squeeze S=Sweep</p>

<p>Security and Safety</p> <p>Shadows park in areas designated for employees. An ID badge is issued and must be worn at all times in order to participate in a shadow experience. Failure to wear the issued ID badge will result in the shadow being dismissed from the facility.</p>	<p>PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)</p> <p>Gowns, gloves, masks, goggles</p> <p>This protection should be used whenever there is a potential for exposure. Handwashing is the most effective means of preventing the spread of infection. Shadows do not enter ANY droplet or airborne isolation rooms.</p>
<p>POST PANDEMIC INFORMATION</p> <p>Students and shadows may wear masks, but they are not required except with some types of isolation and with some vulnerable patient populations, such as NICU.</p>
