Ask staff or instructor for assistance.</p>	<p><b>Rapid Response Team: Dial 88888</b></p> <p>The Rapid Response Team is a team of health care providers who serve as a resource for the general nursing units where there is an actual, perceived or suspected deterioration or change in the patient condition</p>
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<p><b>FIRE Response</b></p> <p>R=Rescue A=Alarm C=Contain E=Extinguish</p>	<p><b>FIRE Response</b></p> <p>P=Pull A=Aim S=Squeeze S=Sweep</p>	<p><b>Confidentiality</b></p> <p>The patient's medical record is confidential and is safeguarded against loss and viewing by unauthorized persons. Only those persons directly involved in the care of the patient are to view the medical record. Under no circumstances is a medical record or copy of a medical record ever to leave the building without proper authorization.</p>

Handwashing is the most effective means of preventing the spread of infection. Shadows do not enter ANY droplet or airborne isolation rooms.</p>
