<p><u>Instructor Responsibilities:</u></p> <p>Determine Student Assignment Review and co-sign student documentation Oversee all patient care performed by student Faculty must always be present on unit with students Discuss with Charge Nurse: Patient care skills performing today, Pre/post student conference time Medication Administration times</p>	<p><u>Student Responsibilities</u></p> <p>Complete patient care as designated Obtain report from RN: At beginning of shift Prior to leaving floor End of shift Report to PCT, LPN, etc. about any remaining tasks left Complete documentation with Instructor's co-signature Only administer medications with Instructor</p>
